The Government of Libya (GoL) has received financing from the African Development Bank (as Administrator of the MIC-TAF Trust Fund) towards the cost of the "Support to Implementation of the Integrated Financial Management and Information System (IFMIS)" project and intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this grant to payments under the contract for a Procurement Expert.
2. The objective of the Project is to enhance the capacity of the Ministry of Finance for implementation of an Integrated Financial Management and Information System (IFMIS). The projects components include:
Component 1.1 - Provision of Human Resources: Recruitment of an IFMIS Specialist as Project Manager, a Project Management Specialist as Assistant Project Manager, and a Procurement Expert Consultant to support the planning and initiation of the IFMIS.
Component 1.2 - Project Management Support: Activities include hiring an external auditor, Procurement expert, Project Completion Report (PCR) consultant, and contingency fund to support effective project implementation and management with the project management unit. 30, June 2025 is the closing date of the project.
3. The consultancy will be carried out by qualified individual consultant and should have:
 - More than 6 years of experience in procurement to public institutions
 - Experience in the international recruitment of expert consultants for various roles.
 - Knowledgeable in local labor laws, specifically those about foreign consultants.
 - Familiarity with the Bank's rules and procedures on procurement is a strong asset.
 - Good understanding of international public procurement principles.
 - Fluency in Arabic and good command of English.

The Support to Implementation of the Integrated Financial Management and Information System (IFMIS)" now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested individual consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (provide updated CV including description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, etc.)

Eligibility criteria, the establishment of the short-list, and the selection procedure shall be under the African Development Bank's "Procurement Policy for Bank Group-funded Operations," dated October 2015, which is available on the Bank's website at <http://www.afdb.org>, using the Individual Consultant (IC) selection method.
